New carers group in Chapel-en-le-Frith

On 9th June Blythe House in Chapel-en-le-Frith started a new carer drop-in session.

Blythe House has been in collaboration with other services in organising the new group – Derbyshire Dementia Information and Advice service (Alzheimer's Society) and Derbyshire All Aged Carer Support Service have been involved and were present at the first session.

Seven carers attended the first event and there was a real buzz of conversation in the room.

Barbara White, dementia adviser in the High Peak spoke to some previous service users and made some new connections with people caring for relatives who were experiencing memory problems but without a formal diagnosis. Several of the carers took away information about dementia.



Carers had the opportunity to speak freely with other carers and professionals from the services attending. The carers in attendance expressed how useful the afternoon had been.

Carers Engagement - ONLINE ONLY

Our online carers engagement session is a informative session developed for carers of people with dementia. Each session is dedicated to a specific topic where information and advice is shared followed by an opportunity for open discussion between carers in a safe and informal environment. These sessions are run in the evening on the first Thursday of each month.

Who can attend: Carers for people with a dementia diagnosis & those awaiting a diagnosis.

Delivered by: This session is co-produced with Derbyshire Healthcare NHS Trust and so a representative from the NHS will be on hand alongside our Group Facilitator.

Co-production groups – MIXTURE OF FACE TO FACE & ONLINE

Derbyshire Dementia Information and Advice Service co-production group is co-produced alongside other local statutory and non-statutory organisations, for example Derbyshire County Council. People with lived experience of dementia can attend the group to take part in discussions and have their voices heard, which in turn will help shape the future dementia services in Derbyshire.
